## My child is sick. Should they stay home?

While there are no longer any pandemic protocols in place, Wolf Creek Public Schools will return to following the public health guidelines that were in place for schools prior to the pandemic. This includes recommending that students and staff stay home when they are sick, or become sick while at school, and contacting Alberta Health Services when absences due to illness are higher than usual.





## Send to School

- Have a runny nose or a little cough but no other symptoms.
- Haven't taken any feverreducing medicine for 24 hours, and haven't had a fever during that time.
- Haven't thrown up or had any diarrhea for 24 hours.

## Stay home

- Have a temperature higher than 100.4 degrees even after taking medicine.
- Have a persistent cough.
- Throwing up or have diarrhea.
- Eyes are pink and crusty.
- Has or has been exposed to an illness where isolation from others is recommended.
